Local Government Elections 2021

The Bi-Annual Local Governments Elections will be held on Saturday 16 October 2021.

In the Shire of Laverton there will be three seats to be contested, each for a four year term.

Whilst the opening of nominations for the elections is still some time off, 2 September 2021, it is important to note that all candidates prior to nominating must complete the online candidate induction from the Department of Local Government, Sport & Cultural Industries website.

Laverton Airfield Contract Management

As alluded to in a recent edition of the Sturt Pea Council has now resolved to enter into a formal contractual arrangement with Aerodrome Management Services (AMS) to manage the Laverton Airfield for the two-year period 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2023. The AMS employees managing the Airfield will be Robert and Wendy Strada.

St John Ambulance – Laverton Sub Centre

The Minister for Health, Hon Roger Cook, in a recent media release, has announced the placement of a Community Paramedic in Laverton.

This has been part of an ongoing campaign with SJA to provide much needed support for the local SJA Volunteers, it appears sometimes the "squeaky wheel" does get the oil.

This is great news and further information will be provided as it becomes available.

Laverton Early Learning Centre

Community members have approached Council in respect to the introduction of a Day Care facility in Laverton. Unfortunately, Child Care and / or Day Care facilities, as they were previously known, are now referred to as Early Learning Centres (ELC), and

there is National Quality Framework in place across Australia for children's education and care services, which must be strictly adhered to.

In acknowledging the benefit that the introduction of an ELC may have for Laverton, Council has resolved to engage the services of an independent consultant to prepare a business plan to investigate and provide an in-depth business and cost analysis for Council to consider.

Laverton Youth Services

The Youth Services closed for a period immediately following the end of January 2021 due to staff resignations.

Over the recent months we have been reviewing the services with respect to meeting the Department of Communities Agreement, meeting the needs / wants of the youth, and coordinating with other agencies / service providers to ensure we are not duplicating activities and seeking an all-round better outcome.

There was some delay in appointing staff to reopen the youth centre but our aim has been to employ the right people not simply to fill the positions because they are vacant. Shari O'Donoghue has been appointed as the Aboriginal Community Liaison Officer to oversee the Cashless Debit Card office and the youth services. As youth services officers, we have appointed Krystal Thompson, Tao Bonney and Dominique Isaacs.

The purpose in employing the three young people to work in the youth services capacity is that they have first-hand knowledge of the youth involved and will be able to engage with them at the required level to ensure they help set up the programs that they can better relate to.

In doing this we have also been consulting with the School, Police, LCCA, Wirrpanda, and Paakanu to set up weekly programs with input from all of the groups to have all encompassing programs.

Laverton Town Rules

The Laverton Town Rules were officially launched at a community function held at the Rotunda in Augusta Street on Wednesday 19 May at 5:30pm.

In introducing the Town Rules it was explained that the Rules have been prepared by the Laverton Stakeholder Group and have been in the development stage for a period of time. The 8 rules have been identified from a history of anti-social behavior experienced within the Laverton townsite, and in consultation with community members and various businesses and agencies. The rules are in no way having a go at or targeting a particular person or group of people, we just want everyone to be able to live and / or visit Laverton in a friendly and respectful way. We also want the community and visitors to appreciate the efforts that a lot of people go to in an endeavor to make Laverton a great place in which to live and visit, and enjoy the many facilities on offer.

Council supports and endorses the Laverton Town Rules and encourages everyone to embrace them and help make Laverton a better place.

It is now proposed to address each of the rules on a monthly basis with the first rule, "Let's keep Laverton clean and tidy, please put your rubbish in the bin", being endorsed as part of the annual Laverton clean-up day in June.

Laverton Airfield Under Cover Area

A short period ago fencing was installed around the car park area at the airfield with the intent of creating an expanded seating and undercover area for the comfort of the passengers arriving and exiting through the terminal.

In progressing the project, we have now received quotations to install shade sails on portion of the area and hopefully these works will commence very soon.

In addition to this we are seeking a quotation for the placement of a small modular building within the fenced area with the possibility of hosting a vending machine for the sale of coffee and other refreshments.




