



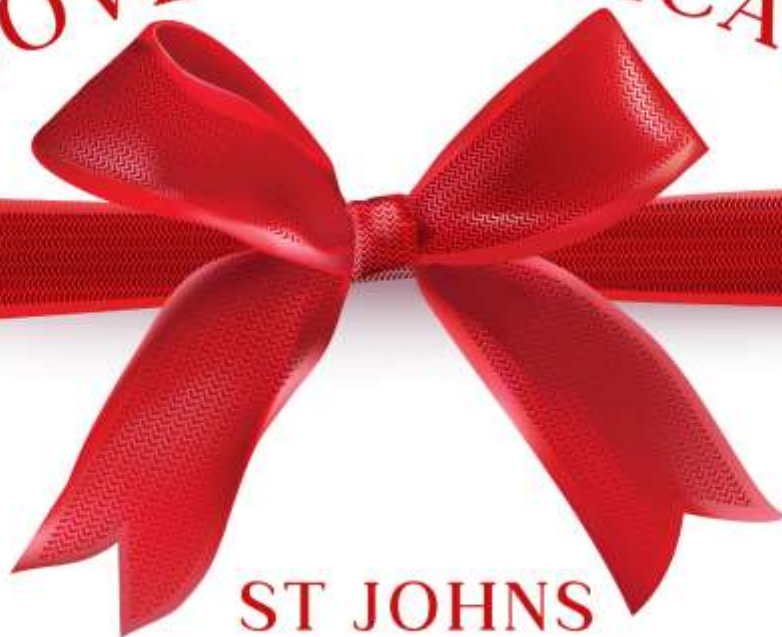

New Pathways Approach Trial to commence in 2023
