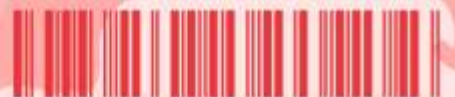

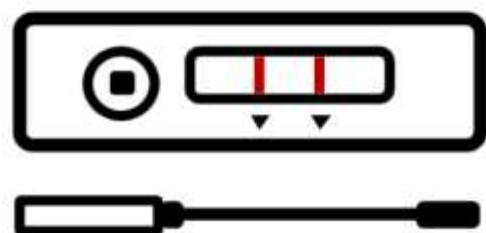

# ROMANTIC SPAGHETTI & MEATBALLS FEATURING 'RINDY'S RUBS'

450 g spaghetti  
450 g minced beef  
30 g bread crumbs

## DIRECTIONS

In a large pot of boiling salted water, cook spaghetti according to package instructions. Drain.

In a large bowl, combine beef with bread crumbs, parsley, Parmesan, egg, garlic, 1 teaspoon salt, and chilli flakes.

Mix until just combined then form into 16 balls.

In a large pot over medium heat, heat oil. Add meatballs and cook, turning occasionally, until browned on all sides, about 10 minutes.

Transfer meatballs to a plate.

Add onion to pot and cook until soft, 5 minutes.

Add crushed tomatoes, bay leaf and 2 tbsps of Rindys Rubs Italian Herb.

Season with salt and pepper and bring to a simmer.

Return meatballs to pot and cover.

Simmer until sauce has thickened, 8 to 10 minutes.

Serve pasta with a scoop of meatballs & sauce.
