The Shire of Laverton would like to inform residents of the progress and upcoming town beautification, projects being undertaken along road projects for the 2023/2024 financial year.

The Council is committed to the town development and putting in place infrastructure to ensure that Laverton grows and develops.

The items covered are random to give a broad perspective of what is occurring within your town.

#### Opening of Duketon Street



Bollards have been removed from the bottom end of Duketon Street. This section will be sealed in November 2023. There is no real reason to keep Duketon Street closed and the flow of traffic behind the War Memorial will be controlled as Laver Park will also be renovated.

Widening of Cox Street



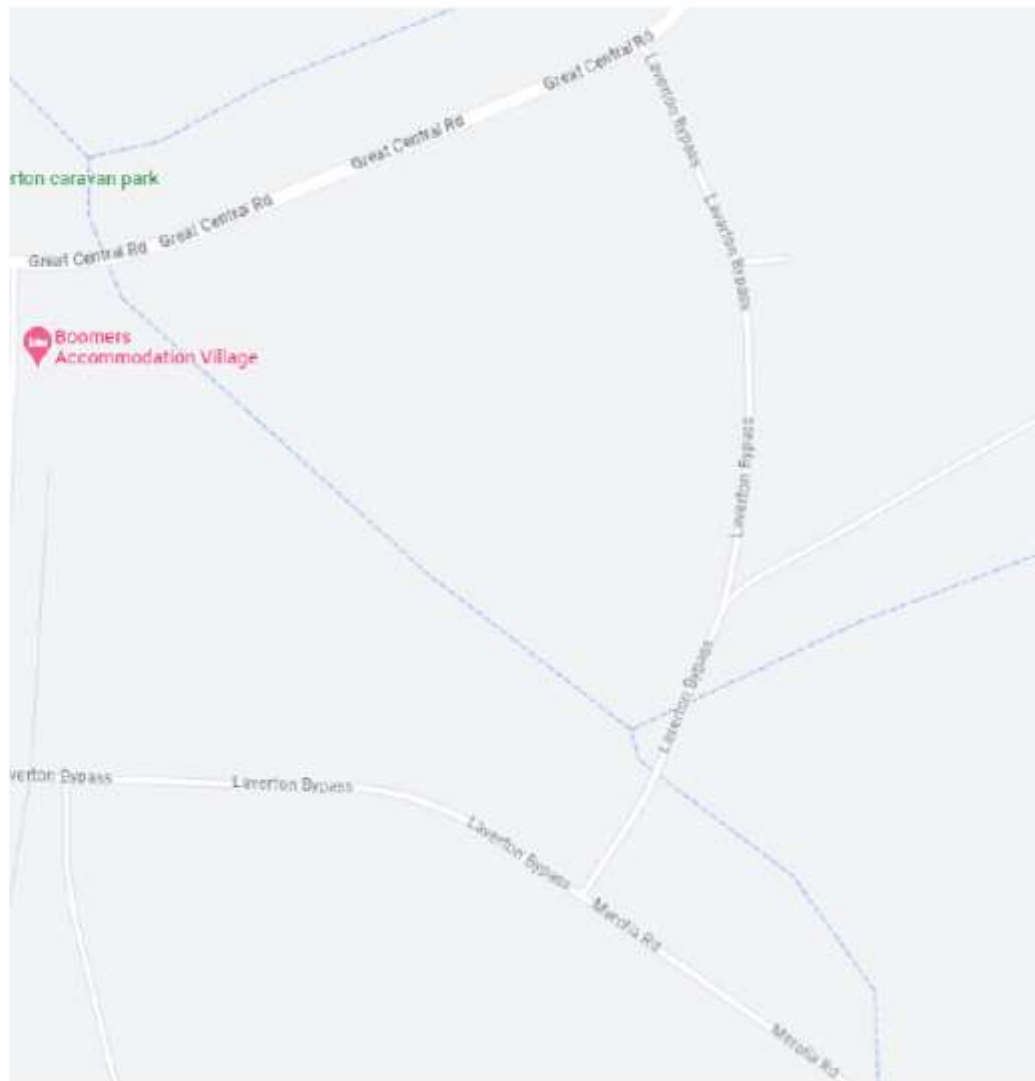
Widening of Crawford Street



These roads will be sealed in November 2023.

Please note that property access along Creation Street and beyond will only have access along Creation to Crawford Streets.

The Racecourse Rd, Merolia Rd and Tip Rd will all be upgraded for sealing in November 2023



## Roundabout







The fake grass has been removed and replaced with the planting of Gazanias which have been chosen for both its beauty and hardiness.



Laverton/Leonora Road from Cox Street to the roundabout

Trees at an advanced stage will be planted to enhance the entrance (Western) into town to replace trees removed over the years. Behind the trees, bollards will be installed to prevent drivers crossing areas and to enhance and direct traffic safety entering roads.

#### Median Strips

- Duketon Street
- Burt Street
- Hawks Place
- Lancefield Street
- Erlistoun Street

These areas will be planted with Kurrajong trees to provide shade and green the town.

The Council is also considering the continual planting of Kurrajong trees and other selected species on the street verges around the town. Further tree plantings will occur around the town oval. Further information to be provided.

#### Coach House Wall Removal

The Council is considering the removal of the wall around the Old Coach House due to the integrity of the wall.

In addition, the entrance to the Community Resource Centre will be moved to the Laver Place entrance, across from the Swimming Pool.

#### Old Youth Centre

This will be a two-stage removal, stage 1, the fencing will be removed and a general clean-up of the site. Stage 2 will be the building itself which includes asbestos removal. This building and fencing are unsightly in the character of Laverton and should not impede the forward improvement of the town. The aim is to open up the town and remove unsightly structures within the main street.



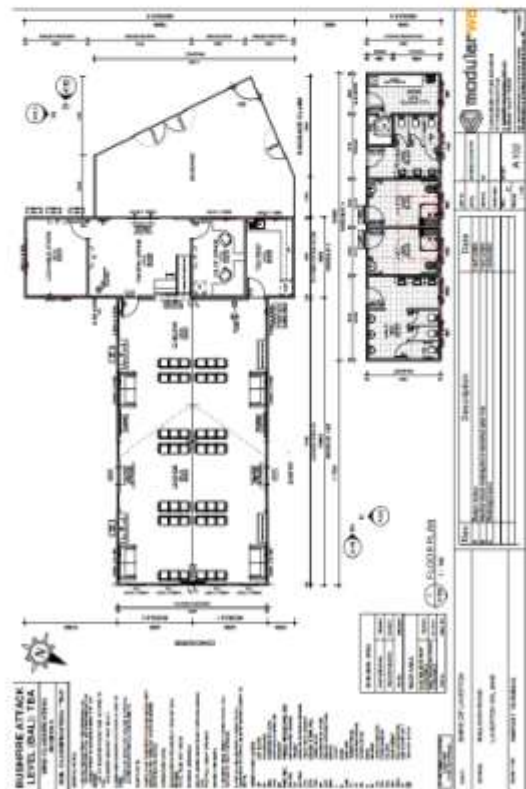
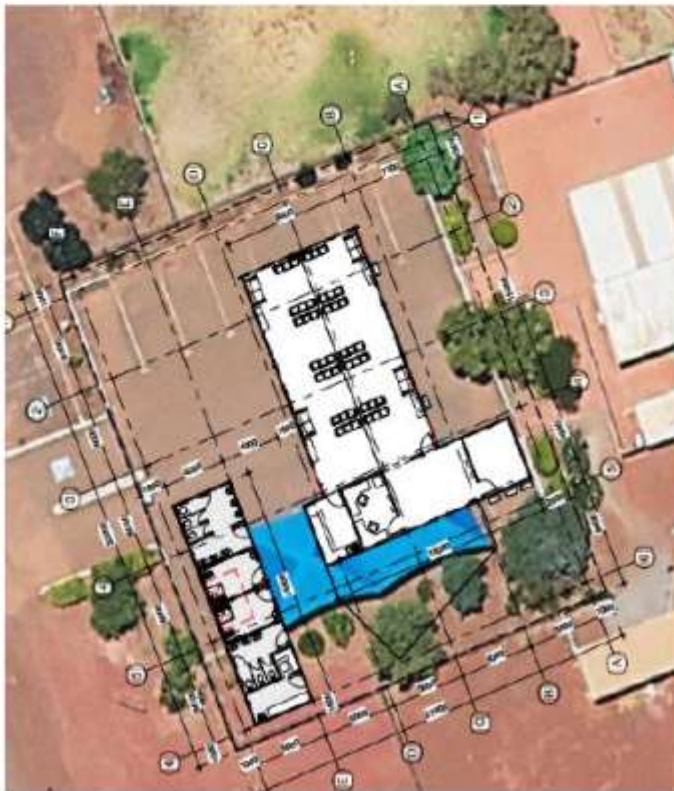


### Airport Upgrade

The Council has authorised the purchase of the attached buildings to replace the existing terminal.

These buildings will be modular in their fabrication and will also include the complete coverage of these buildings by a large roof. The buildings have been designed for practicality and to also allow for further development should the need arise in the future.

The buildings will be built over the existing carpark area so that the operations of the airport are not affected whilst the new buildings are put in place.





The Council is also undertaking a completed reseal of the runway, apron, and taxiway areas and the construction of turning nodes.

#### Reticulation of areas

The Council has undertaken a comprehensive replacement/upgrade of existing watering of gardens, lawns etc following an investigation into the overall watering of these areas.

The Council waters numerous areas by hand and the maintenance costs have escalated and the waste of water is noticeable.

- Leahy Place - War memorial
- Oval

The Council due to shortage of homes within the town has approved a budget allocation of \$2.5 million to build new homes and can be allocated to various government departments to assist in the attraction of new staff to service the town.

In addition, the housing can be added to the council stacks to ensure that it is an incentive to attract staff to Laverton.

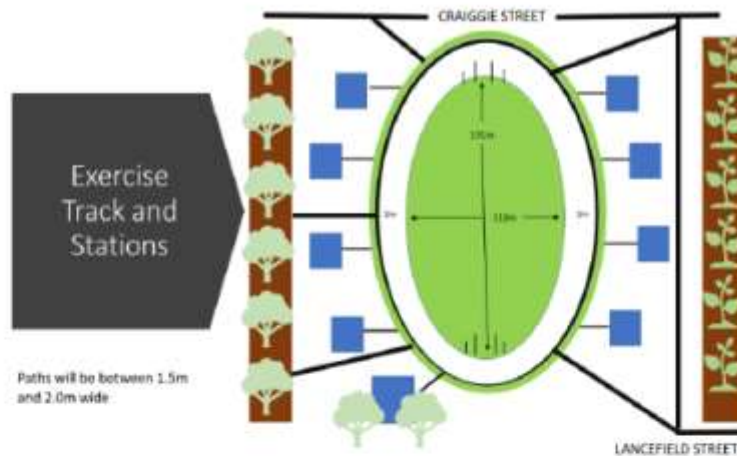
#### Youth

The Council has tried on several occasions to attract youth development to the town without success. 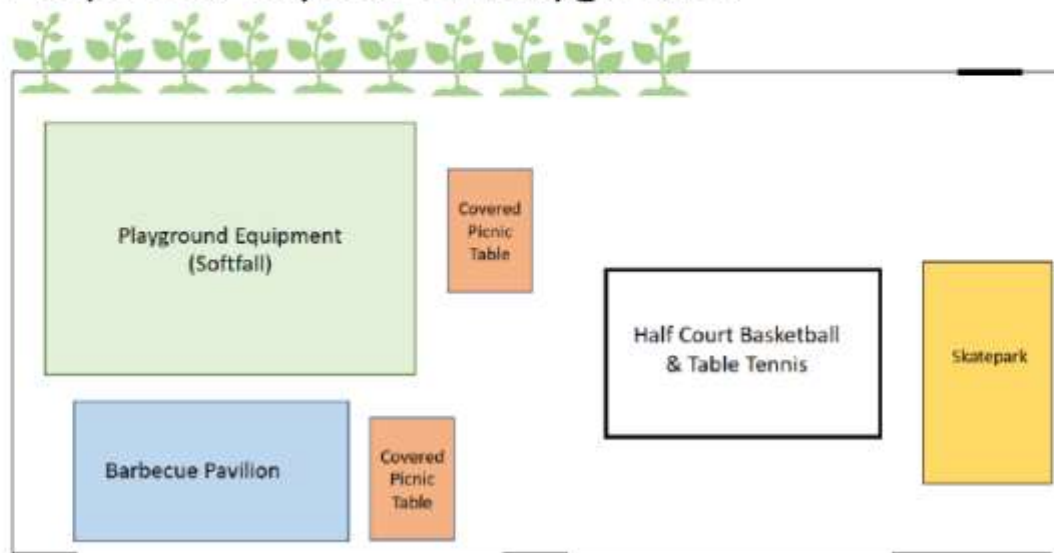

## Proposed Layout of Playground

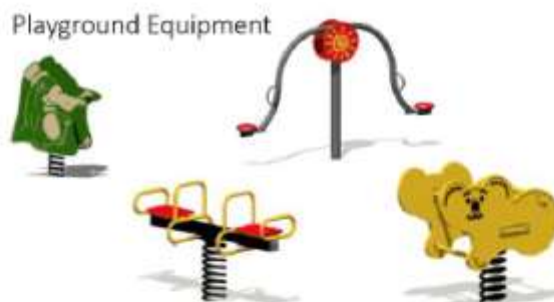


### Basketball Court Area
